- support the transition agenda in European islands. The event will highlight projects in Greece, Italy, Portugal, and Spain; opportunities
- in the Caribbean; and call on relevant organizations and stakeholders to join us within Europe and in support of islands globally, in the
- lead up to the 2025 UN Ocean Conference in Nice, France.
- The event will close with the award ceremony for "<u>Blue Ports and Destinations</u>", curated by BlueMissionMed with the support of MedCruise and in cooperation with the European Commission.
